

Preparatory Course for Admission to Government Schools

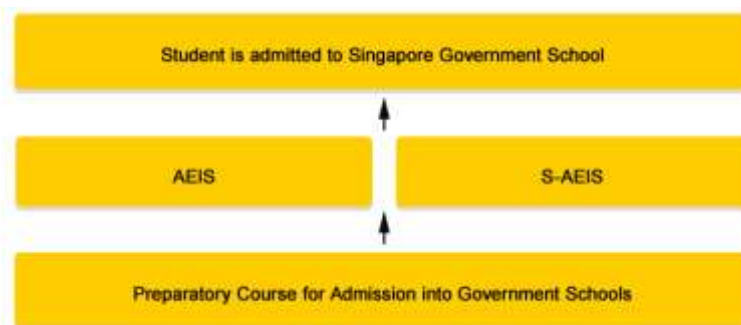
Primary 2 to 5 / Secondary 1 to 3

AEIS Preparatory course is specially designed for foreign students seeking to enter mainstream government schools in Singapore. The course curriculum has a strong emphasis on English and Mathematics to bridge the gap between the foreign and local education systems.

Students will undergo daily intensive lessons where they would be trained in subjects required for the entrance tests (AEIS and S-AEIS).

Admissions Exercise for International Students (AEIS) – Centralised test conducted by MOE (Ministry of Education) on English and Mathematics from September to October for students who wish to join mainstream schools in January of the following year.

Supplementary Admissions Exercise for International Students (S-AEIS) – International students who are unable to make it for AEIS and/or are unsuccessful in previous AEIS attempts can take part in the Supplementary Admissions Exercise for International Students (S-AEIS) from February to March of the following year. However, there will be no admission to the Primary 5 and Secondary 3 levels under S-AEIS. Successful students who passed S-AEIS can join mainstream schools from April to May.



This is a full-time course with 12 Weeks or 24 weeks duration. Lessons will be conducted from Mondays to Fridays, 9am to 12pm and 1pm to 4pm. Total contact hours are 360 contact hours for 12-week programme and 720 contact hours for 24-week programme.
